

ACMPE Board Certification At-A-Glance

Show an entire profession your skill and commitment—follow these steps to your Certified Medical Practice Executive (CMPE) credential:



STEP ONE: QUALIFY AND APPLY

To apply for acceptance into the ACMPE Board certification program you must:

- Have two years of healthcare management experience with six months in a supervisory role
- Be a current MGMA member
- Pay a one-time application fee

Note: Starting January 1, 2019, a bachelor's degree or 120 college credit hours will be required.



STEP TWO: ASSESS AND BUILD KNOWLEDGE

After program acceptance, fulfill three requirements to earn your CMPE credential:

- Pass a multiple-choice exam
- Pass a scenario-based exam
- Earn 50 continuing education (CE) credit hours

Note: CE can be earned 30 days prior to program acceptance, during exam preparation and after passing the exams.



STEP THREE: MAINTAIN YOUR CREDENTIAL

Once certified, you will need to:

- Submit 50 CE hours every three years
- Remain an MGMA member
- Consider ACMPE Fellowship
